Governor Bobby Jindal Announces Appointments to the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board

BATON ROUGE - Today, Governor Bobby Jindal announced appointments to the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board.

The Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board serves to regulate the practices of engineering and land surveying by issuing licenses and certificates to qualified applicants.

According to statute, the board is comprised of eleven members, including nine licensed professional engineers and two licensed professional land surveyors. Two members must be active in the private practice of engineering, two members must be engineers in government employment, two members must be engineers employed in the field of industry, two members must be engineers employed in the field of education, and one member must be an engineer employed in the field of construction. Licensed professional engineering appointees are selected from nominations submitted by the Louisiana Engineering Society, and licensed professional land surveyor appointees are selected from nominations submitted by the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors. All gubernatorial appointments are subject to senate confirmation.

Appointments to the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board:

D. Scott Phillips, P.E., of Monroe, is a registered civil engineer. Phillips is the Regional Engineer for Tensar International Corporation. Phillips will be appointed to serve as a licensed professional engineer representing industry, as required by statute.

Alan Krouse, P.E., of Gonzales, is a registered civil engineer and the Senior Engineer with Buchart Horn, Inc. Krouse will be appointed to serve as a licensed professional engineer representing the private practice of engineering, as required by statute.
